Weekend Schedule

Thursday - Sport North Charter Arrives in Hay River.

Athletes, coaches and chaperones will be picked up at the airport and transported by Frontier Coach Lines to their accommodations.

Biathletes will all be billeted at the Anglican and Roman Catholic Churches which are adjacent to each other and centrally located in downtown Hay River.

All restaurants, the Don Stewart Arena/Aquatic Centre, Movie Theatre are within walking distance of athlete lodging. NWT Biathlon will be covering the costs for lunches and trail snacks throughout the weekend. See the attached schedule for lunch times at the ski club.

Biathletes, coaches, chaperones will be issued free passes for use throughout the weekend at the aquatic centre. There are no showering facilities at the athlete accommodation sites. Everyone is welcome to use the showers at the aquatic centre. Aquatic Centre schedule is attached. Remember to bring bathing suits and towels.

The buses will pick up out of town athletes each morning (Friday 8:30 am, Saturday 9:00 am and Sunday 8:00 am) to deliver to the Hay River Ski Club. The return bus pick up: Thursday 4:00 pm, Friday 3:00 pm and Sunday afternoon approximately 2 pm - exact time to be announced pending updated info on Sport North charter schedule.

dispensers are available at the ski club.

All ammunition will be provided.

If requested, firearms will be available.

Bring bathing suits and towels. Showering will be at the aquatic centre.

Indoor runners are required since cold weather may necessitate indoor fitness testing.

Friday will be a training camp day. This will be the time to get organized, outfitted and set for the weekend's competitions. There will be plenty of

support for novice participants.

Friday and Saturday Trials' Races start and finish at the same place at 'Home on the Range'.

The Ski Club waxing room will be open at all times for your convenience.
